TERMS AND CONDITIONS

A licence is required to berth and/or sail your own equipment on the Welsh Harp. Purchase of a licence does **not** guarantee a berth. Applicants for a licence must be full sailing members of BTYC, not social members.

Any own boat or board based or sailed at the Welsh Harp must be insured and carry current third party insurance for at least £1,000,000.

- Boats, boards and trailers are kept on the site at the owner's risk.
- The Berth Master may move boats (at the owner's risk) to alternative berths in order to facilitate the management of the boat park. Similarly, the windsurf bosun may move boards at the owners' risk.
- Boat licences will be available for collection by boat/board/trailer owners from the Club House on Saturdays for 1 hour before and for 1 hour after racing, or by arrangement up to and including 30 June of the current year.
- The correct licence sticker is to be attached by the owner as follows:
 - Stayed-mast boats (GP14): to the front of the mast, visible above the top level of the cover.
 - Un-stayed-mast boats (Laser, Topper): on the transom visible below the cover edge.
 - Board licence pennants must be attached to the rig being sailed and be visible at all times.
 - Trailers must be marked according to WHSA requirements.
- After 30 June, paid-for but uncollected boat licences will be attached to licenced boats by the Berth Master and the boat moved to the 'dead' end of the boat park, furthest from the water, or to any other place as seen fit.
- Unlicenced boats/boards/trailers will be put up for sale according to the Club Rules.
